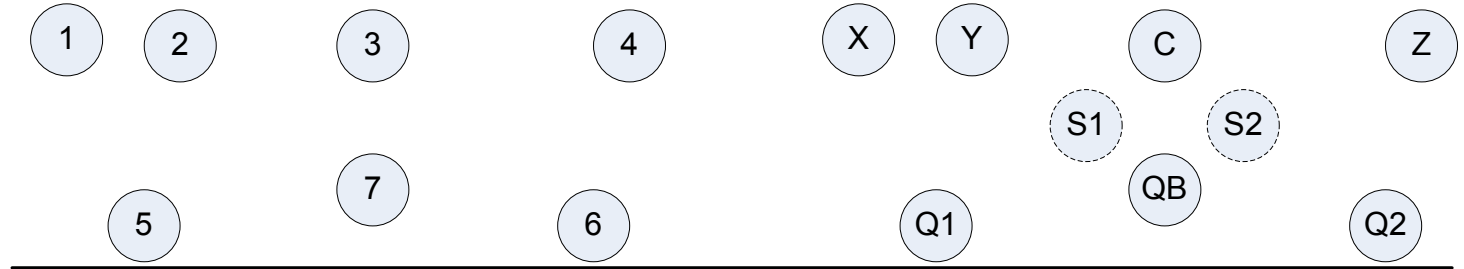


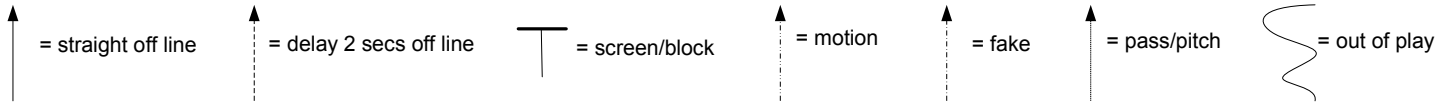

Player Postions and Letters



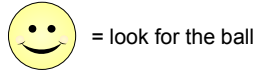
Pattern Lines

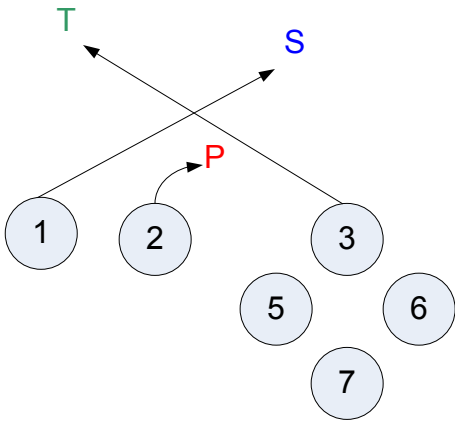
If nothing else, the playbooks will improve your perception of organization and intimidate your opponents.

Mixed Formation – Run Plays vs Zone

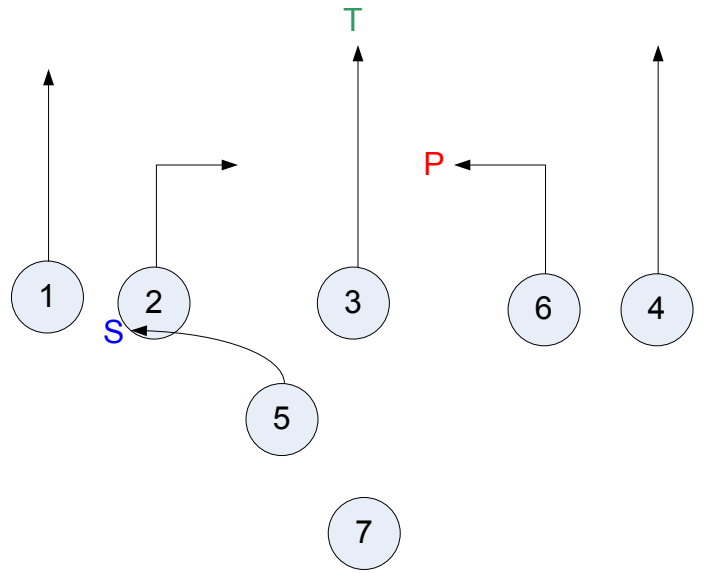


Screen Formation – Short Yardage vs Zone



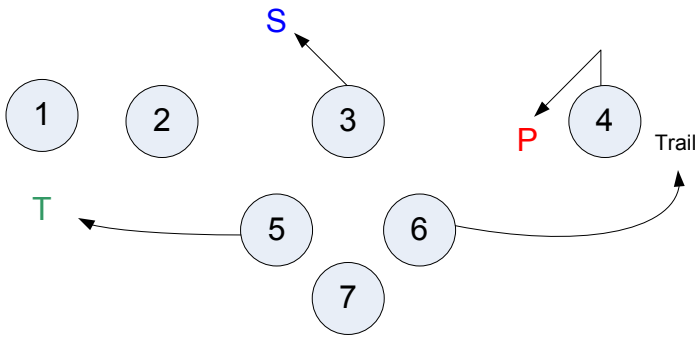
Screen Formation – Cross Up Slot Pop

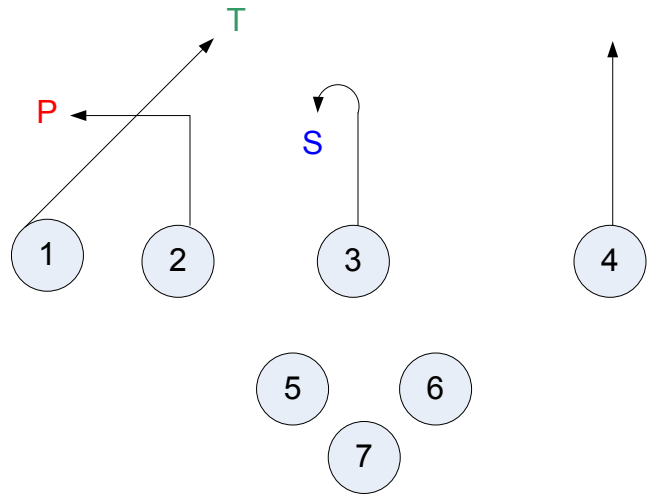
Double Slot Formation – Quik In

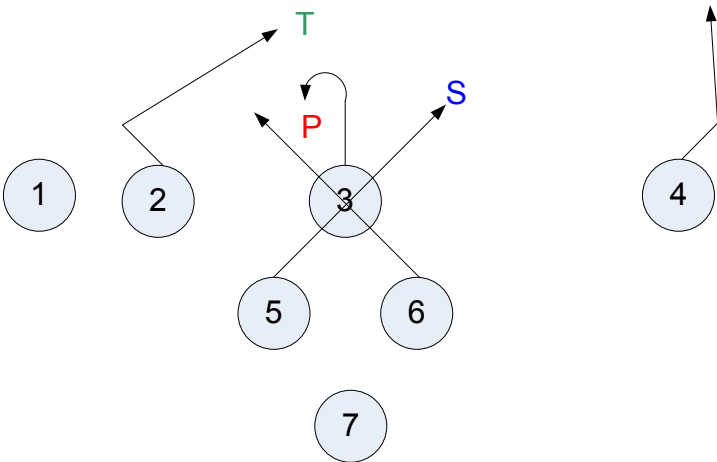
Screen Formation – Hitch-n-Pitch

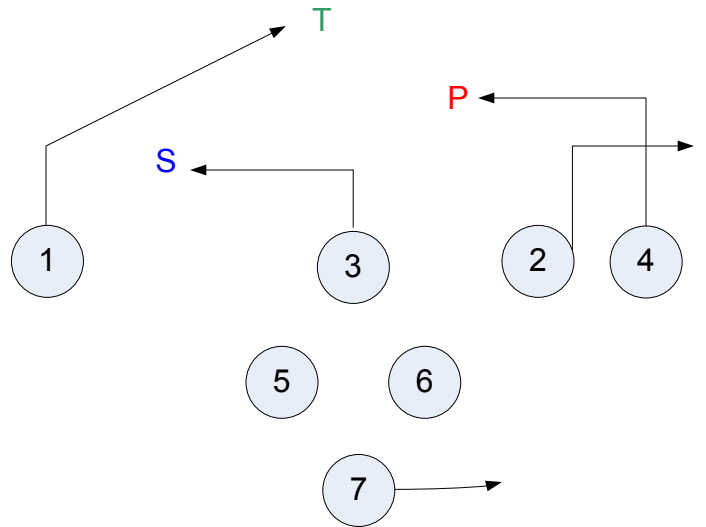
Screen Formation – Quik out

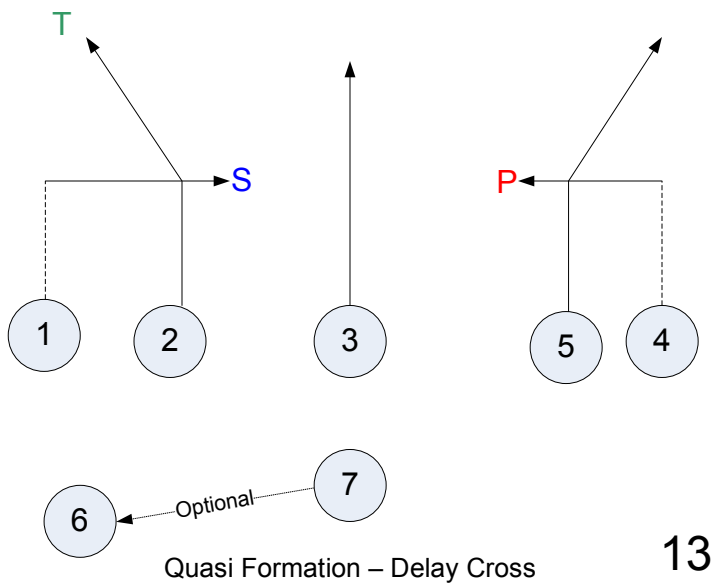

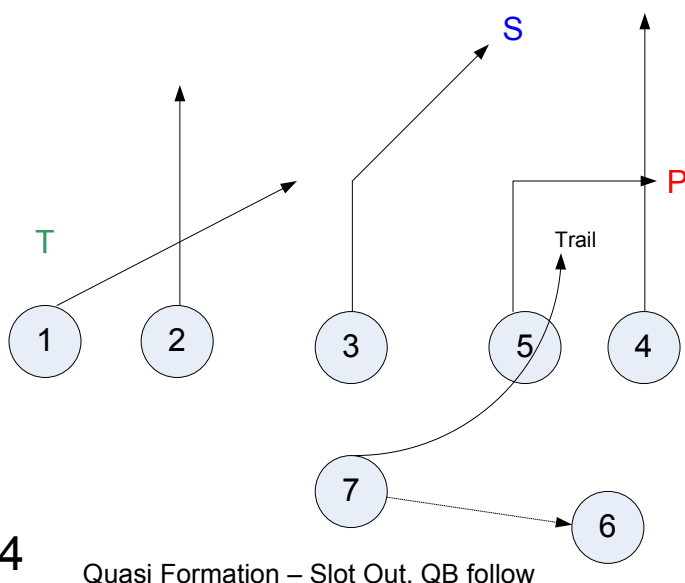

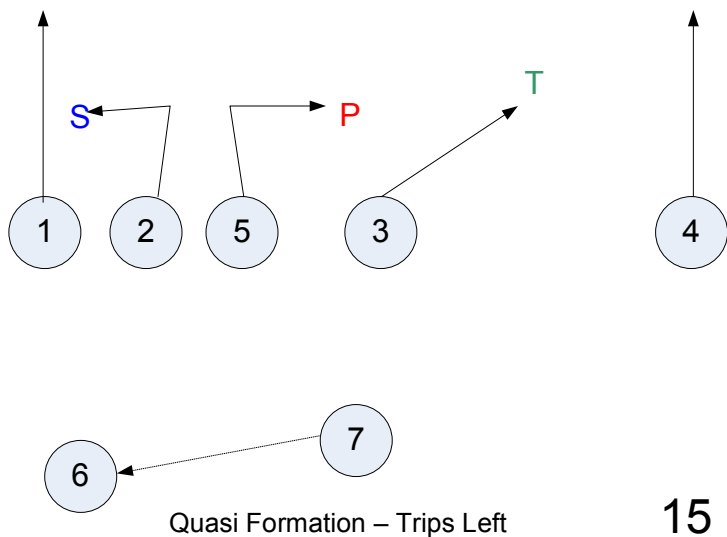
Quasi Formation – Short Yardage vs Zone



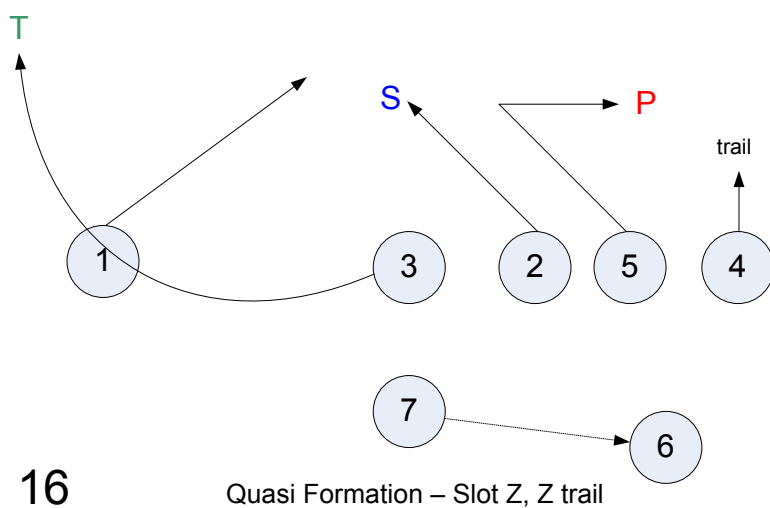

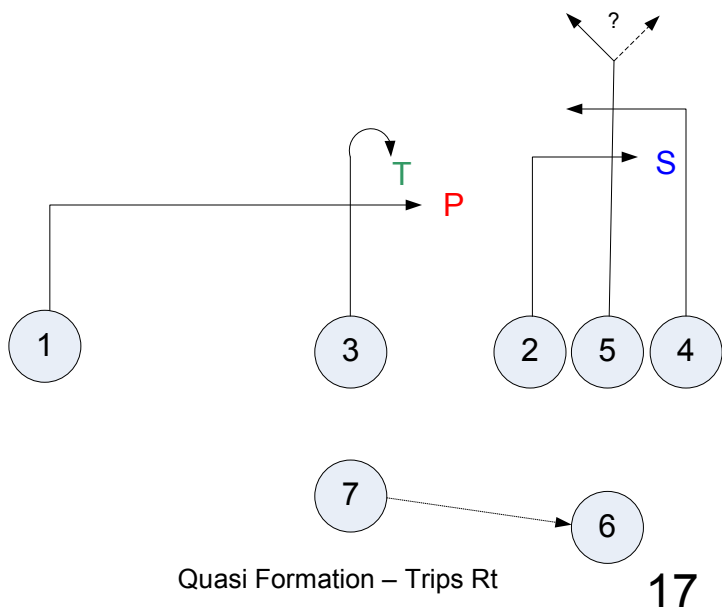

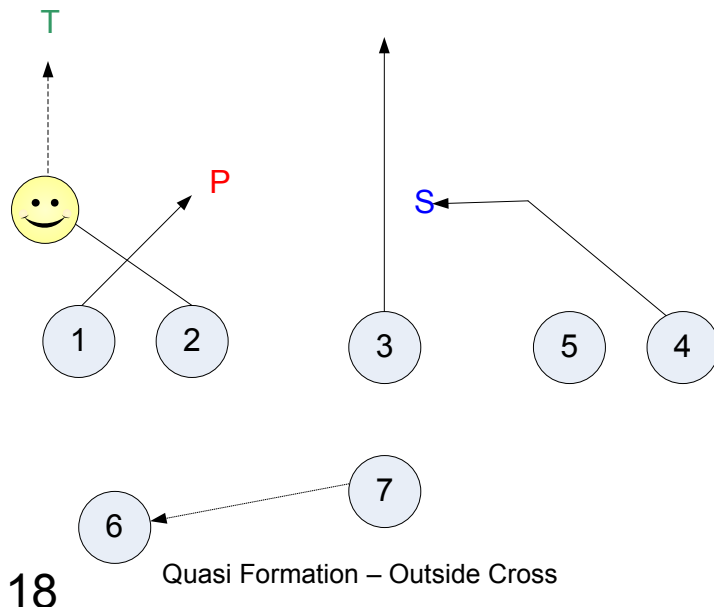
